Be Fire Smart!

Bayside is filled with old, beautiful, <u>wooden</u> houses. We have had devastating fires in the past, and we are always alert to the potential for stray sparks and fires. Wood smoke from a fire without a permit can trigger a "false alarm," requiring the Fire Department to needlessly mobilize and respond. Every cottage should have a copy of our Fire Ordinance; there are also copies at the Village Office. Some of these rules are state law; some are just common sense; <u>all</u> of them make for a safer Bayside!

There are basically four types of controlled fires:

Fire Type	Do I need a state permit (through the Town of Northport?)	Do I need permission from the NVC Board of Overseers?
1) Bonfire (on the beach)	Yes*	Yes
2) Camp fire	Yes*	Yes, or must meet several requirements**
3) Fire place (fire pit)	No	Yes, or must be at least 75 feet from any abutting dwelling or structure
4) Grill	No	No, but must be monitored

^{*}State fire permits are available at the Bayside Store or Northport Town Hall.

Remember: NEVER leave your fires unattended. When done, extinguish your fire completely. Always keep a cell phone and fire extinguishing equipment at hand.

Violating our Fire Ordinance can incur fines of up to \$1,000. Questions? Stop by the Village Office!

^{**} Campfires must be on the Intertidal Zone, 25 feet from any combustible material, and 75 feet from any structure.
