Report on Saturday Cove Float

The Town of Northport has offered to transfer ownership of the float to the Northport Village Corporation (NVC) at no charge. NVC will be responsible for relocating float to Bayside. The float could be moved as soon as April 28 if the transfer is approved by the Board Overseerers.

Craig Brigham moved that the WSC recommend that the NVC Board of Overseers accept ownership of the Saturday Cove float. The motion was seconded by Bill Haverty and passed with unanimous support, with thanks to the Town.
